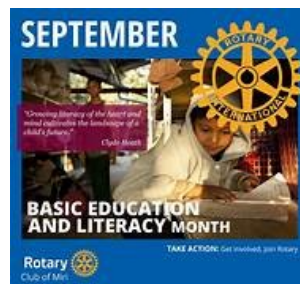

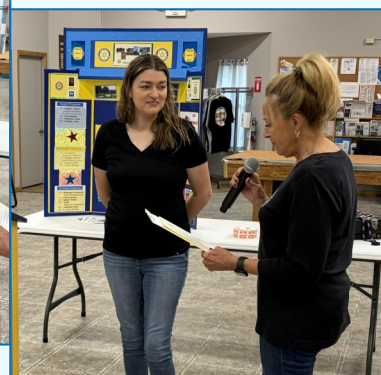

united in the ideal of service .

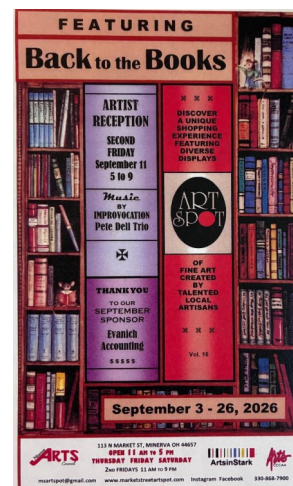
The Purple Pinkie Project



The Rotary International service project,
END POLIO NOW, continues its work
to eradicate polio. We can participate
through a district wide Purple Pinkie Project
modeled after a project originated by fellow
Rotarians in eastern Tennessee.

For every dozen sold, a \$10 donation will be made
to Rotary International's END POLIO NOW project.
The donation is also eligible for the 2-1 match
by the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation.

The Purple Pinkie Donuts come in boxes of 12
and require a prepaid \$22 donation. Donation only
gifts are also accepted. Preorders need to be placed
and paid by October 6th. Donut pick-up
and distribution will be October 19 -23.
